

- II. Purpose
 - A. To establish the classification medical requests for all EMS providers.

- III. Definitions
 - A. Emergent: a situation in which there is a real or perceived need for immediate action, attention or decision making to prevent mortality or to reduce serious morbidity.
 - B. Urgent: a situation in which there is a real or perceived need for immediate action, attention or decision making to reduce morbidity, but where no life threatening situation appears to exist.
 - C. Non-emergent: a situation in which there is no perceived need for immediate action, attention or decision making to prevent mortality or to reduce serious morbidity.


