- I. Authority and Reference (incorporated herein by references)
 - A. Division 2.5 of Health and Safety Code
 - B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22
 - C. North Coast EMS Policies and Procedures

II. Purpose

To identify responsibility for medical direction to prehospital care personnel who are out of their normal response area or zone during mutual aid, auto aid or other pre-arranged coverage.

III. Policy

Prehospital care providers who are operating in a response area outside of their normal zone shall contact the base or alternate base hospital with jurisdiction over the area of call origin, regardless of the provider's base hospital.

IV. Procedure

Approved:

- A. A prehospital provider shall contact the base or alternate base hospital who has jurisdiction over the area of call origin for purposes of medical direction and patient reporting.
 - 1. Example: If ambulance A is covering ambulance B's zone due to call volume, ambulance A is considered to be an extension of B and will contact B's base or alternate base hospital, if possible.
- B. If the cover crew is unable to contact the base hospital of the covered area, they are to contact their normal base hospital and operate as per policy.
