**Hospital Communication Log**

- I. Authority and Reference (incorporated herein by references)
  - A. Division 2.5 of Health and Safety Code
  - B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22
  - C. North Coast EMS Policies and Procedures
- II. Purpose

To define the policy for maintaining a radio and/or telephone communication log.

## III. Policy

- A. Every base hospital or alternate base hospital shall document radio and telephone communications concerning patient care on a communication log.
- B. Every patient contact reported by field providers shall be documented on the hospital communication log.
- C. The communication log is to be reviewed as part of the approved Continuous Quality Improvement system.
- D. North Coast EMS recommends that the communication log contain the following at a minimum:
  - 1. Facility.
  - 2. Date and time of call to hospital.
  - 3. Patient identification (name, hospital or ED ID number, etc.).
  - 4. Treatment Protocol being followed
  - 5. Abnormal Vital signs or ECG.
  - 6. Orders if given and ER MD name.
  - 7. ETA to facility.
- E. Form design and layout will be left up to the individual facility.
