## Subject:Administration - CommunicationsAlternate Communication During Radio Failure

- I. Authority and Reference (Incorporated herein by references)
  - A. Division 2.5 of Health and Safety Code
  - B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Section 100124
  - C. North Coast EMS Policies and Procedures

## II. Purpose

To provide a back-up base hospital communications during a period of radio failure or the unavailability of an MICN or ED physician at the original base hospital or alternate base hospital.

III. Procedure

If radio failure with the assigned base hospital occurs, or if the base hospital or alternate base hospital is unable to provide medical control for a period of time, but communication with a second base hospital is possible, the BLS/ALS unit shall contact the second base hospital for orders if the patient's condition deteriorates. The BLS/ALS unit may contact the second base hospital for physician or MICN consultation on an "as needed" basis.

- A. The BLS/ALS unit and the second base hospital should consider diverting a deteriorating patient to the closest appropriate facility.
- B. The second base hospital shall update the receiving hospital by landlining with relevant information.
- C. The BLS/ALS unit shall document the involvement of the second base on the Prehospital Care Report (PCR).
- D. The BLS/ALS unit shall submit the PCR upon delivery of the patient to the receiving hospital and the receiving hospital shall submit a copy of the PCR to the second base hospital.
