Student Eligibility for Paramedic Training Programs

II. Purpose

To establish regional policy for eligibility to enter North Coast EMS approved Paramedic training courses.

III. Policy

- A. Paramedic student eligibility:
 - 1. Possess a high school diploma or general education equivalent: and
 - 2. Possess current EMT certificate, NREMT-Basic registration or California EMT-11 certificate.
 - 3. Current basic life support card according to the American Heart Association healthcare guidelines.
- B. Documentation that verifies the above must be submitted when requesting North Coast EMS Paramedic Accreditation.
