## Associated Policies:

## I. Priorities

- A. ABC's.
- B. Identify signs of shock.
- C. Administer Oxygen per policy.
- D. Determine the degree of physiologic distress, estimate amount of blood loss.
- E. Rapid transport, if unconscious or conscious with progressive symptoms.
- II. Vaginal Hemorrhage with Shock Post Delivery of Infant and Placenta:
  - 1. Ensure a patent airway and provide high concentrated oxygen.
  - 2. Transport early to appropriate facility.
  - 3. Provide (external) uterine massage.
  - 4. IV access Two (2) large bore cannulas Administer fluid titrated to blood pressure. Recheck vitals after every 250cc or five (5) minutes.
  - 5. Transport patient left lateral with legs elevated.
  - 6. Reevaluate bleeding and visually check perineum.
  - 7. If working for a North Coast Approved Agency, administer Pitocin per Policy 5412.
  - 8. Contact hospital early.

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
